This order shall dispose of the appeal filed by Shri K. Jagadeeswaran in respect of ID No.23.

- 1. Present Shri K. Jagadeeswaran, Appellant on 21.05.2019
- 2. Present Shri G.M. Maske, PIO/ Chief Accounts Officer
- 3. All present heard.
- 4. The applicant had requested for providing attested photocopies of his monthly CPF contribution statement from **1.4.1997** to **31.03.2000** and from **1.04.2015** till **08.03.2019**. The PIO/CAO vide his reply dated 08.04.2019 had provided requisite information from 1.4.15 to 8.3.19. With regard to period from 01.04.1997 to 31.3.2000, PIO had stated that the information is not available in the section.
- 5. The Appellant has contended that the reply received from CAO is incomplete, misleading and in correct and he is requesting information as it is related to his personal CPF account.

- 6. The PIO/CAO during the hearing stated that the specific information which the appellant was seeking was not available in the accounts section and therefore was not made available to the appellant. The appellant stated that his only purpose for seeking information was to ensure that correct contribution was made to his CPF account through deductions from his salary as well as the Institute's contribution.
- 7. It came out during the hearing that there are other parallel records such as PBR (Pay Book Register) from which the doubts raised by the appellant can be addressed. The PIO/CAO is directed to facilitate inspection of these parallel records viz. the PBR which may establish FTII's as well as appellant's contribution from 1.4.1997 to 31.3.2000. The inspection should be facilitated by the PIO/CAO within 10 days from issue of this order.

The appeal is therefore disposed of.

If the appellant is not satisfied with the information provided, he may file an appeal before Central Information Commission, August Kranti Bhawan, Bhikaji Cama Place, New Delhi – 110 066 within the stipulated time.
